**PROHIBITION OF RECREATIONAL MARIJUANA
ESTABLISHMENTS AND FACILITIES ORDINANCE**

An ordinance to provide a title for the ordinance; to define words; to prohibit marihuana establishments and facilities within **SCIOTA TOWNSHIP** pursuant to initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951; to provide penalties for violation of this ordinance; to provide for severability; to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith; and to provide an effective date.

SECTION I

TITLE

The ordinance shall be known as and may be cited as, the **SCIOTA TOWNSHIP PROHIBITION OF MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS AND FACILITIES ORDINANCE**.

SECTION II

DEFINITION

Words used herein shall have the definitions as provided for in Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 et seq., as may be amended.

SECTION III

NO MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS OR FACILITIES

SCIOTA TOWNSHIP hereby prohibits all marijuana establishments or facilities within the boundaries of the township, pursuant to initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL 333.27951 et seq., as may be amended.

SECTION IV
SEVERABILITY

- 1 Any person who neglects or refuses to comply with any provision of this ordinance or who causes flows or consents to any of the same shall be deemed to be responsible for the violation of this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is deemed to be a nuisance per se.
- 2 A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, for which the fines shall not be less than \$100 or more than \$500, in the discretion of the Court. The foregoing sanctions shall be in addition to the rights of the Township to proceed at law or equity with other appropriate and proper remedies. Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township incurs in connection with the municipal civil infraction.
- 3 Each day during which any violation continues shall be deemed a separate offence.
- 4 In addition, the township may seek injunctive relief against persons alleged to be in violation of this ordinance, and such other relief as may be provided by law.
- 5 This ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Ordinance Enforcement Officer of the township or by such other person(s) as designated by the Township Board from time to time.

SECTION V
VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence word, section, provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION VI
REPEAL

All ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII

EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect . May 8
2019.
