NOTICE OF ROADS SPECIAL ASSESSMENT HEARING TO RENEW SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT TOWNSHIP WIDE; AND RENEW A ROADS SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR 10 YEARS, AND TO CONSIDER OBJECTIONS TO THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT LEVY AND CONFIRM THE ASSESSMENT ROLL.

TO: The residents and property owners of Sciota Township and other interested persons:

The Township Board has estimated the cost and expenses for maintaining and improving roads in the Township and accordingly the day has been fixed for a hearing on the cost estimates and on the question of establishing a special assessment district and levying a special assessment per household and to distribute the Special Assessment levy so as to defray the expenses of maintaining and improving roads by special assessment on the property to be especially benefitted.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on September 11, 2017, at 7:10 p.m. there will be a public hearing at the Sciota Township Hall located at 3990 Leland Road, Laingsburg, Michigan, to consider renewing a Roads Special Assessment District which encompasses all of Sciota Township, and to levy a Special assessment against each residential household property owner within Sciota Township, in the amount of \$50.00 per year for Ten years and to consider objections to the distribution of the Special Assessment levy.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that appearance and protest at this hearing is required in order to appeal the amount of special assessment to the State Tax Tribunal if an appeal should be desired. A property owner or party of interest, or his or her agent, may appear in person at the hearing to protest the special assessment or may file his or her appearance by letter delivered to the clerk by mail or in person by 7:10 p.m. on September 11, 2017, and his or her personal appearance shall not be required. The property owner or any person having an interest in the property subject to the proposed special assessment may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the State Tax Tribunal within thirty days after confirmation of the special assessment roll if that special assessment was protested at this hearing.

At said hearing the Sciota Township Board will consider any written objections to any of the foregoing matters which might be filed with said Board at or prior to the time of said hearing as well as any revisions, corrections, amendments and/or suggestions.

All interested persons are invited to be present at the aforesaid time and place and submit comments on any of the foregoing.
