WINTER 2020 TAXES

Save yourself time and gas, pay by mail. The Tax statements are perforated. Simply tear off at the perforation and keep the lower half for your records. If you would like a receipt mailed to you, please write "yes" on the top portion you are sending in with payment. Please send your check or money order, made out to "Sciota Township Treasurer", to:

Office Hours for Winter Tax collection are as follows:

**Monday, December 28th 9am - 5pm
Monday, March 1st 9am- 5 pm**

While the Treasurer is required by law to keep specific office hours pursuant to PA 641 of 2002, she will be available to collect your taxes most other times too. PLEASE CALL Kim Palmer at 651-6245 (or email her at Treasurer@sciotatownship.net) to make arrangements.

Some reminders for you:

- You may pay for multiple parcels on one check, as well as adding your dog license fee to the same check
- There is a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks (NSF)
- The last day to pay without any late fee is February 16th, 2021. Mail must be post marked on or before February 16th

ANIMAL LICENSE

If your veterinarian is in Shiawassee county, you may purchase your animal license from them, or you may purchase when paying your taxes.

You **MUST** send in or bring with you:

- Proof of current rabies vaccination by an accredited veterinarian
- proof of sterilization or neuter if applicable
- The attached form filled out. All certificates will be returned to you with the license. Feel free to photocopy form for additional animals.

Animal licenses are due by Tuesday, March 1st 2021. Fees are listed below. Stop by whenever the Treasurer is home, your best bet is to call first (517) 651- 6245.

- After March 1st, license(s) may be purchased at the County Treasurer's office.
- Delinquent license fees are \$60.00 (non-neutered) and \$20.00 (neutered).
- Any animal four (4) months or older must have a license. If you are licensing more than four (4) dogs, you must have a kennel license. Please call Animal Control at (989) 743-2406 to obtain such a license.
