

Sciota Township Board Meeting – August 10, 2020

The August 10, 2020, meeting of the Sciota Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Matthews at 7:00 p.m. at the Sciota Township Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all. Members present were Supervisor Matthews, Clerk Parker-Wing, Treasurer Doyle, Trustee Reed and Trustee Vondrasek. Guests present were Mike and Diane Dowler, Cindy Garber, Dennis Hill and Jim Fox.

MINUTES: Vondrasek moved to approve the July 13 minutes as written, seconded by Reed—motion approved by all.

TREASURER’S REPORT: No new reports from the treasurer. Parker-Wing made a motion to place treasurer’s report on file, seconded by Matthews—motion approved by all.

1st PUBLIC COMMENT. None

COMMISSION REPORT. Commissioner Garber says the county audit is being held up due to departments not getting information to the auditor. The audit is already past a 30-day extension by the state. Veterans do not seem to be asking the county for help with their property taxes.

LSW EMERGENCY REPORT. Dennis Hill reported there were 6 rescues, 3 fires, and 56 calls to the LSW this month.

BOARD REPORTS: Supervisor Matthews talked about whether we need a second application of brine on the roads or whether we need brush/spray completed this late in the season. The DEQ is cleaning out the Looking Glass River and removing brush and fallen trees along the way. Clerk Parker-Wing says we’ve trained 5 new election poll workers. The Invisalink internet service cannot get a signal from the hall roof top, so inquiries will be made with Verizon and satellite companies. Treasurer Doyle, Trustees Reed and Vondrasek had no new news.

NEW BUSINESS: Reed made a motion to cancel the 2nd application of brine with the Shiawassee County Road Commission, agreement #497.012.200112, seconded by Vondrasek. Matthews made a motion to adopt a Personal Property Canvass Policy and Procedure, 10 pursuant to MCL 211.10e and 10b to conduct personal property canvasses; seconded by Parker-Wing.

2nd PUBLIC COMMENT. Jim Fox requested the county gradall 2 areas of the road in front of his house where topsoil made it into the side ditch.

BILLS APPROVAL: Matthews made a motion to pay bills, seconded by Reed—approved by all.
