**SHIAWASSEE COUNTY MILLAGE PROPOSAL  
FIRE SERVICES MILLAGE BALLOT PROPOSAL**

Shall the Township of Sciota limitation on general ad valorem taxes be increased by one mill (which is equal to \$2 per 1,000 of taxable value of all real and personal property subject to taxation) each year for a term of 5 years (2024 through 2028 inclusive) for the purpose of operation and maintenance for emergency services (which includes but is not limited to the payment for equipment, supplies, insurance, wages, building construction, repair and other expenses of the fire department operations). It is estimated that if this millage is authorized that in the first year the township will receive \$155,208.00.

**SHIAWASSEE COUNTY MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previously voted levy of 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value), reduced to 1.9679 mills (\$1.9679 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, against all taxable property in the County of Shiawassee, Michigan be renewed at the rate of 1.9679 mills (\$1.9679 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for 4 years beginning in 2024 through 2027 inclusively, to provide funds to assist in the operation of the Pleasant View Shiawassee County Medical Care Facility? The County estimates that it will collect \$4,833,900 in the first calendar year if this proposal is approved.

**SHIAWASSEE COUNTY MILAGE PROPOSAL  
CLINTON COUNTY REGIONAL  
EDUCATION SERVICE AGENCY  
SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy the special education millage previously approved by the electors and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 2605 mill (\$0.2605 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Clinton County Regional Education Service Agency, Michigan, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability, be renewed for a period of 20 years, 2025 to 2044, inclusive, and also be increased by .0517 mill (\$0.0517 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 20 years, 2025 to 2044, inclusive, the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2025 is approximately \$873,448 from local property taxes authorized therein (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2024 tax levy and a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
